


HENI announces the latest print release from new Shepard Fairey, Damien Hirst and Invader collection

HENI releases *Third Eye Butterfly Mandala*, two limited-edition prints by Shepard Fairey and Damien Hirst. The prints are available in two different sizes and are based on new works currently on view at the *Triple Trouble* exhibition at Newport Street Gallery. The prints are available on HENI Editions from 5 March until 17:00 GMT on 16 March 2026. The number of editions will be limited by demand during the release window.

The editions are Giclée prints on smooth cotton rag, presented in white aluminium frames with UV acrylic. The small prints measure 107.1 x 80.9 cm (framed) and are priced at \$2,500 (plus applicable taxes) each. The large prints measure 226.9 x 167.3 cm (framed) and are hand-signed by Shepard Fairey and Damien Hirst and hand-numbered on the front.

In *Third Eye Butterfly Mandala*, Fairey and Hirst focus on the mandala, a design which has historically appeared in the work of both artists. The circular mandalas are composed of Hirst's meticulously arranged and variously coloured images of butterfly wings, a motif that he has long used as a 'universal trigger' for themes of love, beauty and mortality. At the centre of the mandalas are Fairey's *Make Art Not War* girl and the third eye, together communicating a message of peace and harmony.

"A mandala is a symbol of unity and wholeness and harmony for the planet. So, these pieces that are about peace and harmony are really conveyed with the materials used, the subject matter, and I think that they came together very powerfully." – **Shepard Fairey**

"I love working with Shepard, he's a great artist and a great human being and there aren't many people around who have both those qualities never mind artists and he gives a shit more than most in a world where hope is in short supply, oh and he's a punk!"



Shepard Fairey

Shepard Fairey is a contemporary street artist, graphic designer, activist and founder of OBEY Clothing and the creative agency Studio Number One. In 1989, while at Rhode Island School of Design studying for his Bachelor of Fine Arts in Illustration, Shepard Fairey created the *Andre the Giant has a Posse* sticker that later evolved into the OBEY GIANT art campaign. In 2008, his portrait of then-Democratic candidate Barack Obama became an internationally recognised emblem of hope. He is known for the 'We The People' campaign debuted during the 2017 Women's Marches worldwide. Fairey has painted nearly 140 public murals and has become one of the most sought-after and provocative artists globally, changing the way people converse about art and view the urban landscape.



Damien Hirst

Damien Hirst (b. 1965) was born in Bristol, England, and lives and works in London, Devon and Gloucestershire, England. Collections include Museo d'Arte Contemporanea Donnaregina, Naples, Italy; Museum Brandhorst, Munich; Museum für Moderne Kunst, Frankfurt am Main, Germany; Stedelijk Museum, Amsterdam; Centro de Arte Dos de Mayo, Madrid; Tate, London; Israel Museum, Jerusalem; Astrup Fearnley Museet, Oslo; Gallery of Modern Art, Glasgow, Scotland; National Centre for Contemporary Arts, Moscow; Museum of Modern Art, New York; Hirshhorn Museum and Sculpture Garden, Washington, D.C.; Art Institute of Chicago; The Broad, Los Angeles; Museo Jumex, Mexico City; and 21st Century Museum of Contemporary Art, Kanazawa, Japan.

Exhibitions include *Cornucopia*, Oceanographic Museum of Monaco (2010); Tate Modern, London (2012); *Relics*, Qatar Museums Authority, Al Riwaq (2013); *Signification (Hope, Immortality and Death in Paris, Now and Then)*, Deyrolle, Paris (2014); Astrup Fearnley Museet, Oslo (2015); *The Last Supper*, National Gallery of Art, Washington D.C. (2016); *Treasures from the Wreck of the Unbelievable*, Palazzo Grassi and Punta della Dogana, Venice (2017); *Damien Hirst at Houghton Hall: Colour Space Paintings and Outdoor Sculptures*, Houghton Hall, Norfolk, England (2019); *Mental Escapology*, St. Moritz, Switzerland (2021); *Cherry Blossoms*, Fondation Cartier, Paris (2021); *Archaeology Now*, Galleria Borghese, Rome (2021); *The Weight of Things*, MUCA, Munich (2023-2024); and *To Live Forever (For a While)*, Museo Jumex, Mexico City (2024). Hirst received the Turner Prize in 1995.




TT4-1A (Large)


TT4-1B (Small)


